£8.73 per hour in the most recent cohort. Wages consistently above the National Living Wage for all age groups

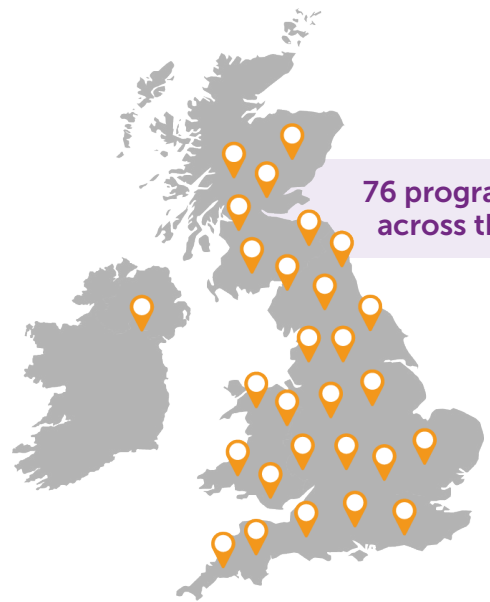
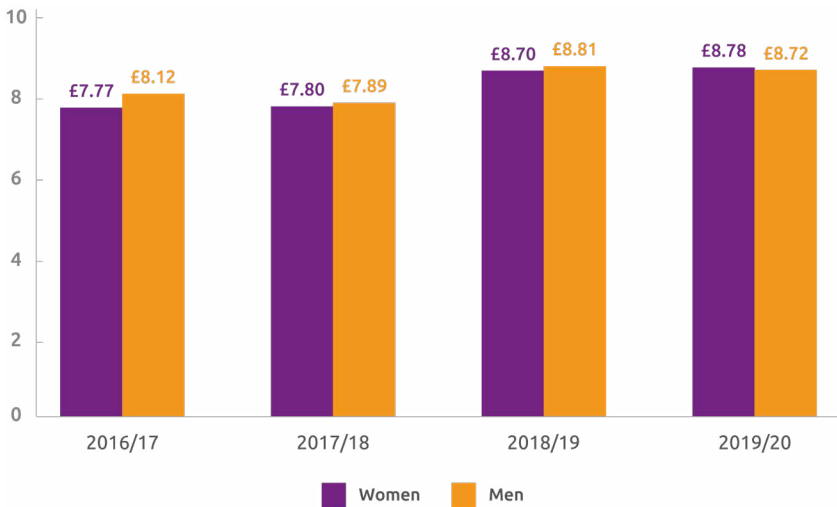


We have set up a **Youth Advisory Board** to ensure interns and graduates play an active role in shaping our work
